

Our million pounds target is based on an estimate of the combined cost of work on Church and Church Centre, and is subject to review at this early stage

Full development plans and costings for both building updates are currently being drawn up, with more details to be published later in 2017



The essential work on our church roof has begun and is costing an estimated £270k, for which we have so far raised £136k. We are of course keen to raise the remainder as soon as possible, so that loans can be repaid and we can move on to the rest of this exciting project ...
