How do you plan to use your time, talents and treasure for God this year?

Giving of money

Each year, we ask all our church members to reconsider our gifts to the church, thinking about how we can offer our time and our money to support God's ministry in this place

It costs around £4306 each week to run our church

Diocesan Parish share Clergy stipends, pensions, housing, supporting other Churches	£1283
Running costs e.g. Church upkeep (lighting & heating), Salaries (organist, children's' worker, verger, administrator), Church Office	£2348
Ministry and Mission Worship resources, Mission events, Children and Youth work etc.	£675
Total	£4306

But at present our forecast church income for 2018 will fall short of this by £809 per week. After allowing for income from the church centre, **we need to increase our stewardship income by 13% to cover our costs** ...

We currently have 193 people who commit to give regularly to St Mary's each week or month. More are needed : **Can you sign up to our stewardship scheme**?

If you already give regularly : **Please can you consider** raising your giving by 10%, or even 15% per week?
