### **HCT NIGHT SHELTER FOR THE HOMELESS PROJECT**

**1st December 2017-15 March 2018**

St Mary's team, led by Manny Holden and Denise Herrington, will be coordinating and operating the HCT Night Shelter for the Homeless this winter from Kingdom Faith Church on Saturday evenings. We need members of our congregation to help support the Night Shelter and to volunteer for a number of different roles. The roles involve:

- Being a volunteer on one of the three shifts – early evening, overnight or breakfast
- Cooking a hot meal off site and delivering it to Kingdom Faith Church in time for supper
- Collecting bedding from the venue on a Friday evening and delivering it to Kingdom Faith Church

If you volunteered previously, or have never volunteered before, full training will be given. Key dates to keep free for training are Wednesday 8 November (evening 1830 – 2130) or Saturday 11 November (2 – 5pm). Training is important and every volunteer will need to attend one of these sessions (although if you attended a full training course last year, on site training at KFC is all you will need to do).

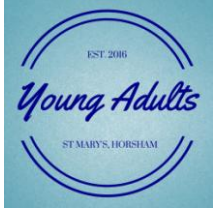
