Prayer Room (upstairs at the back of the church): Our Prayer Room is currently set up to help us to pray for our new Team Rector, Lisa, and her family as they prepare to come. We are praying too for our own church and others in this time of transition. The Prayer Room is available whenever the Church is open.

Vicarage Carpets: During the last few months the Vicarage had been decorated throughout and all the old carpets removed. Lisa and Stephen have now chosen the carpets they would like and we are ready to place the order to have them put down before they move in. The cost of the carpets is going to be in the region of £8,500 or to look at it another way - £25 per metre. We get minimal support (£350) from the Diocese to prepare the Vicarage for our new Vicar. We are therefore appealing to our St Mary's family to raise the money for the new carpets. Could you spare £25 for one square metre of carpet?
