Eighteen people enjoyed taking part in the Bioblitz Wildlife Survey in the churchyard including some local experts from outside the congregation. Away from the neatly mown areas it might look as though we only grow nettles and brambles, but we found around 100 species of flowering plants and at least 42 different mosses and liverworts. We also have 18 different tree species in the churchyard. More results expected soon.

We have started a "Needs" board where our Ukrainian English students can list any items they may be in need of. We then try to source those items with donations from the congregation and community. The list is on a board at the back of the church and if you think you can help with an item, please write your name next to it. Any donations should be labelled and left at the Welcome desk in the church.

Some are arriving in Horsham able to continue their former jobs by working remotely.
